ORDINANCE NO. 742

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.33 OF THE  
VILLAGE CODE WITH RESPECT TO VIDEO GAMING REGULATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Greenup (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation organized and operating under the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and laws of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Greenup is authorized to enact such rules and regulations for Video Gaming by and through Chapter 5.33; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Greenup have determined that it is necessary to amend its existing ordinance regulating liquor licenses.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENUP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:** The facts and statements contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

**SECTION TWO:** AMENDMENT – Chapter 5.33 is hereby amended by adding the bold, underlined language and deleting the stricken language to read as follows:

5.33.070 Eligible Licenses

The number of permits issued under this chapter shall be limited to ~~seven~~ **eight (8)**.

**SECTION THREE:** SEVERABILITY – In the event that any section, clause, provision or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all parts that are severable shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

**SECTION FOUR:** CONFLICTING ORDINANCES – All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided however that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of actions which shall have accrued to the village prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**SECTION FIVE:** EFFECTIVE DATE – This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




