**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 13 OF THE
VILLAGE CODE WITH RESPECT TO UTILITY PAYMENT PENALTIES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenup (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation organized and operating under the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenup is authorized to enact such rules and regulations for utility billing by and through Chapter 13.18; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Greenup have determined that it is necessary to amend its existing ordinance regulating penalties for late payments or payments that are returned for non-sufficient funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENUP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION ONE: The facts and statements contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION TWO: AMENDMENT – Chapter 13.18.080 is hereby amended by adding the bold, underlined language and deleting the stricken language to read as follows:

13.18.080 Payment Responsibility-Bills-Late penalty.

A. The rates or charges for service shall be payable monthly.

B. The owner of the premises, the occupant thereof and the user of the service shall be jointly and severally liable to pay for the service to such premises and the service *is* furnished to the premises by the village only upon the condition that the owner of the premises, occupant and user of the services are jointly and severally liable therefore to the village.

C. For any utility payments that are paid after the due date, a ten percent (10%) late fee penalty shall be applied.

D. In the event a payment is returned due to insufficient funds, the charges shall be deemed delinquent and the Village Clerk shall advise the relevant utility supervisor to disconnect such delinquent user without further notice. A penalty of \$50 shall apply for reconnecting such user that is disconnected due to insufficient funds whenever application is made for reconnection and the delinquent bills and charges are paid in full.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY – In the event that any section, clause, provision or part of this ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all parts that are severable shall remain in full force and effect. If any part of this ordinance is found to be invalid in any one or more of its several applications, all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications shall remain in effect.

SECTION FOUR: CONFLICTING ORDINANCES – All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided however that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of actions which shall have accrued to the village prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE – This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

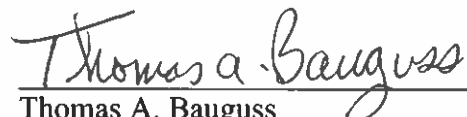

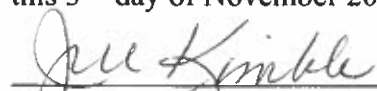
