ORDINANCE NO. 765

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 5.01.02 OF THE VILLAGE CODE PERTAINING TO LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenup, Illinois is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation organized and operating under the constitution and laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village derives its rights, power and authority from the various sections of the Municipal Code and the Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Greenup, Cumberland County, Illinois, currently regulates its liquor license by and through Section 5.01.02 of the Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined it is in the best interest of the Village to amend Section 5.01.02 to update the amount of Class D liquor licenses available to be issued each year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GREENUP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION ONE: The recitals set forth hereinabove are hereby incorporated as findings as if said recitals were fully set forth within this Section One.

SECTION TWO: That Title 5, Chapter 1, Section 5.01.02 (Licenses) of the Village Code is hereby amended with the additions in bold, underline text, and deletions with strikethrough, as evidenced by the language below:

5.01.02 Licenses.

F. Classification--Fee--Limitation. Every person engaged in the retail sale of alcoholic liquor in the Village shall pay an annual license fee. Such licenses shall be divided into the following classes:

4. Class "D" licenses shall authorize the retail sale of by restaurants of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises. Class "D" licenses may only be permitted as follows:

- (a) In a restaurant dining area provided that the sale is incidental and complementary to the sale and service of a complete meal served and eaten at a table within the restaurant; or
- (b) In a bar service area adjacent to the dining area located within a restaurant, with or without the sale of a meal.

The annual fee for the license shall be \$600. There shall be no more than ~~one (1)~~**two (2)**

license issued during any year.

SECTION THREE: All Ordinances and Resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: If any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. The Village Board declares hereby that they would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance if they had known that such part or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional.

SECTION FIVE: The Village Clerk of the Village of Greenup is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval in accordance with the manner prescribed by law
